BACKGROUND: Each month district staff compiles attendance and enrollment data for all school sites. The attached summary shows enrollment and ADA for 2019-2020 compared to current year 2021-2022.

STATUS: District-wide enrollment **decreased by 81** students compared to the same month of school year 2019-20, decreasing from 1,929 to 1,848 (does not include Adult Ed), due to COVID-19 enrollment ADA is compared to 2019-20.

District-wide enrollment **decreased by 1 students** compared to **last month (November)**.
(Does not include Adult Ed)

District-wide attendance **decreased by 16 ADA** compared to **last month (November)**,
1,673 to 1,657. (Does not include Adult Ed)

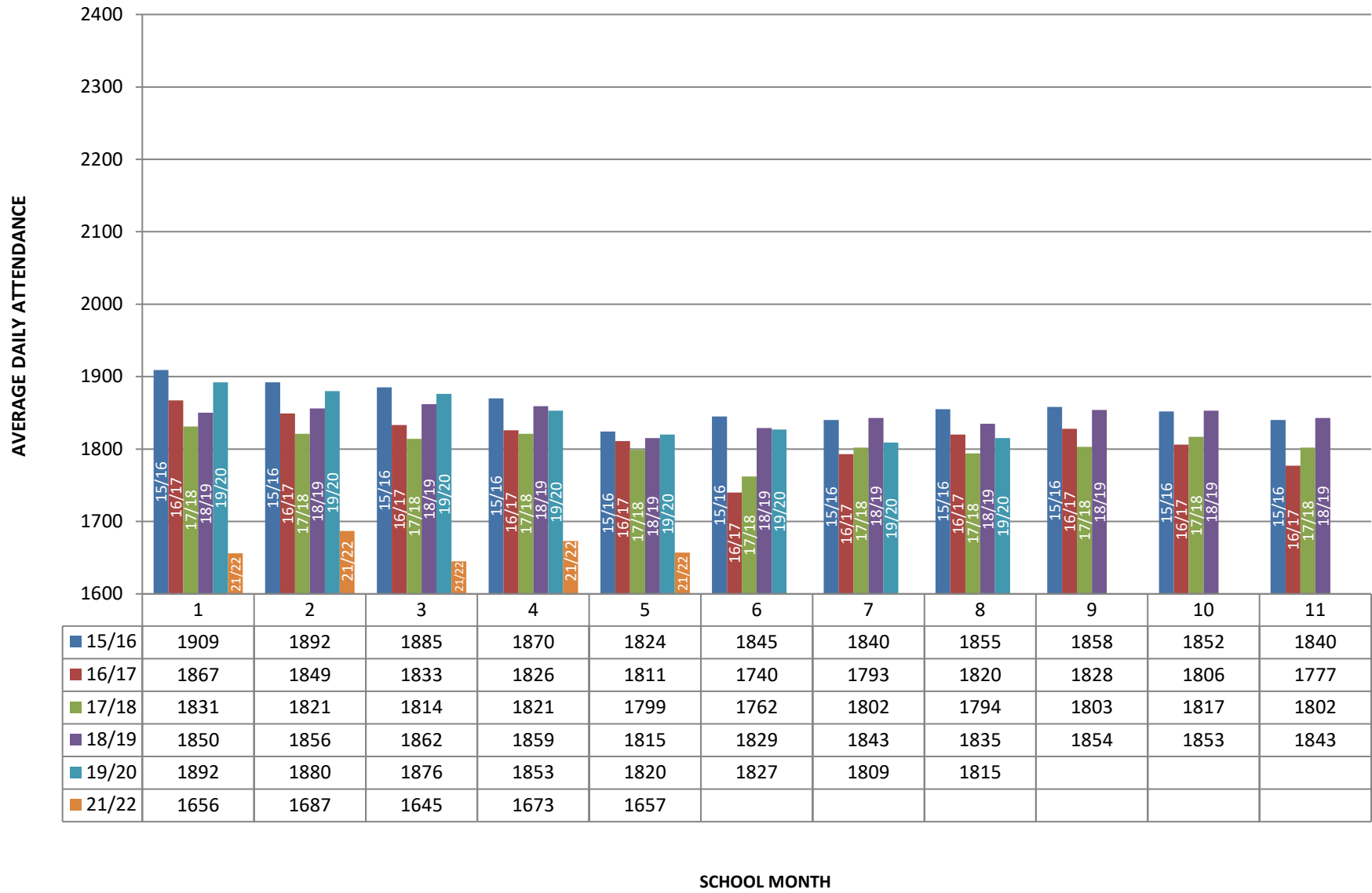

6. **Report of Action taken, if any, during the Closed Session** (Government Code Section 54957.1)
Board President Stone reported that the Board received information; no action taken during Closed Session.
7. **Review and Approve the Open Session Agenda**
Board President Stone asked for a motion to approve the Open Session Agenda.
 - Member Lamera moved to approve, Member Riley seconded. Motion carried 6 (Ayes: Mahoney, Riley, Lamera, Apel, Jelly, Stone): 0 (Nays): 1 (Absent: Casillas)*
8. **Public Comment:** Christy Van Loben Sels greeted the members of the Board and thanked them for allowing her to speak on a topic that is high priority for many parents. The topic she addressed is Governor Newsome's state mandate for K-12 student Covid "injections" required to attend in person learning. She shared a few facts she obtained from the CDC and other resources relating to Covid related deaths, as well as the fact that immunized individuals are no less infectious as unvaccinated people. Ms. Van Loben Sels listed potential adverse effects of the vaccination. She understands why this issue is so controversial. However, she feels that the vaccinations should be a personal choice and not mandated by the government. Ms. Van Loben Sels spoke of a template titled "Urgent Request to Governor Gavin Newsom to rescind the Covid-19 Vaccination Mandate for Public and Private K-12 Students as a Requirement for In-Person Education". She shared a copy of it with the Board.

Kristen Hutson expressed her gratitude of the Board for welcoming and encouraging parent involvement and input. She is very concerned with the Governor's proposed Covid "injection" mandate. She supports the desire of the Board to communicate with Governor Newsome the negative effects the mandate will have on our families, our schools and our District and ask him to rescind the mandate. She feels parents should have the rights to make these medical decisions.

Lisa Friend thanked the Board for their service to the community and the support of the children. She stated that she is an employee of a large urban school district in the Sacramento area. Ms. Friend is aware of the concerns regarding funding and the reliance we have on the State to keep the districts running. She also understands the fear of monetary retribution if the District would take a stand against the vaccination mandate. She spoke of LA Unified and what took place in their district regarding the vaccination mandates being suspended and that is her goal. Ms. Friend hopes the District will work with the families to ensure the safety of the children, their right to make medical decisions, and their ability to attend schools where they live. Ms. Friend noted that no one should have to live in fear, fear of an illness, fear of ramifications, fear of medical interventions, fear of not attending school, or fear of losing funding while supporting the students and families.

9.1.2.1 2 X 2 Committee – No reports given

9.1.2.2 Trustee Area Redistricting Committee – Member Jelly reported that the committee, which included herself, Member Lamera, Superintendent Wright and Mrs. Gaston met with the Sacramento County GIS Analyst, Mr. Demers. Mr. Demers reviewed the criteria required when considering redistricting lines. The criteria consisted of keeping the voting population within 10% of each other and special populations. She noted that in our District the Hispanic population would be considered a special population. Member Jelly mentioned that during our meeting Mr. Demers shared his screen showing how the population numbers changed as voting blocks were either added or deleted to each Trustee Area. The last Board meeting it was suggested to keep the Trustee Areas preserved. However, at the committee meeting, Mr. Demers explained that this would not be appropriate or taken into consideration. A map was created using the appropriate criteria such as the special populations, and it turned out that each incumbent resides in their current Trustee Areas. Member Jelly feels that the proposed map is a true representation of the District.

Member Lamera reported that we reach out to a member of the California Redistrict Commission, Commissioner Fernandez. She is also a former River Delta Unified School District Board President for feedback.

Superintendent Wright noted that tonight we are providing a committee report to showing the progress from the last meeting. Further on, there is an agenda item where a Public Hearing will be held, allowing the public the opportunity to make comments and provide input.

9.1.3 Superintendent Wright's report(s) greeted all those in attendance. She announced that she would be dedicating her time to honor the District's 2021-2022 Teacher of the Year.

9.1.3.1 Recognition of River Delta Unified School District's 2021-2022 Teacher of the Year, Julie Griffin – Katherine Wright, Superintendent stated that it is a true honor and privilege to publicly recognize as River Delta Unified School District's Teacher of the Year, Julie Griffin. Superintendent Wright gave a summary of her work in the District that spanned many years, starting as an English teacher in 1998 at Rio Vista High School, and, after many recruiting efforts by Mrs. Turk, she returned in 2016 to Rio Vista High School as the Graphic Design Teacher. Mrs. Griffin has developed the most popular and productive CTE Pathway at Rio Vista High School. Mrs. Griffin has dedicated her time and has worked very hard to make sure that the courses are articulated with the Junior College, allowing

the students to receive college credit while completing her classes. She has been honored twice for the outstanding yearbooks produced by the Rio Vista High School students under her guidance. Mrs. Griffin also manages Radio Rio, which is a favorite of the students and many community members. Superintendent Wright had many more adoring comments commending the person Mrs. Griffin is and what she means to our District.

Mrs. Griffin said a few words and thanked her family and the wonderful staff members she has the privilege to worked with.

9.2.1.1 ADA/Enrollment Report – Tammy Busch, Chief Business Officer reported that the District-wide enrollment has had an increase of 19 students and an increase in ADA of 28 compared to last month.

Member Lamera reminded the Board that although we disbanded the list of possible school closures, the District would be following the enrollment of the schools in question. He requested that either the January or February Board meeting he would like to have the principals report of their attendance and what progress has been made to increase the enrollment. Ms. Busch stated that February will be a good month as we will have the P1 Attendance Reports. Member Mahoney would like to see what the cost per student at each school site. Ms. Busch noted that we complete a Per Pupil Expenditure Report which will be completed by February 1 ready for the Schools Accountability Report Card.

9.2.1.2 Monthly Financial Report – Tammy Busch, Chief Business Officer noted that the report figures are year to date actuals as of November 30, 2021.

9.2.1.3 Developer Fee Report – Tammy Busch, Chief Business Officer reported that annually, within 180 days of closing the fiscal year, local agencies that collect developer fees must prepare the annual developer fee for the public and Board.

This letter confirms that our firm would be pleased to represent the River Delta Unified School District (the "District") in connection with compliance with federal communications laws and the rules and policies of the Federal Communications Commission, particularly as pertains to radio station KRVH. Stacy Toledo or other attorneys of Parker & Covert LLP may act and/or serve as the District's representative during our representation.

In order to protect clients from misunderstandings, the D.C. Bar's Rules of Professional Conduct require that all fee and billing arrangements be set forth in writing. The purpose of this letter is to set forth clearly our fee arrangement and to provide other relevant information about our representation.

Rates. We bill for legal services rendered on an hourly basis. Our current rates for legal services range from \$240-\$250 per hour for paralegals, \$280-295 per hour for associates, and \$395-675 per hour for Members and Counsel. I will provide the majority of the legal services for the District, and my hourly billing rate is \$395.

We usually require a retainer before we begin representation of a new client. We will waive this requirement for the District.

Clients are required to pay for any FCC filing fees electronically or by separate check directly payable to the FCC, although as a noncommercial educational station, KRVH is exempt from most FCC filing fees.

Payment Terms. We will bill on a monthly basis and, unless otherwise agreed, payment is due within 30 days. If a statement is not paid within 45 days, we will have the right to charge interest on the unpaid balance at the rate of one percent per month from the date of the



statement. If a statement remains unpaid for more than 60 days, we will have the right to withdraw as your attorneys. In the event that we must retain counsel and/or utilize our own attorneys and paralegals to collect sums owed to us by you, you agree to be liable for reasonable attorneys' fees, reasonable fees for our own legal services based on our standard hourly rates, and court costs which we may incur in connection with such collection matters, and you agree that the local and federal courts of the District of Columbia will have jurisdiction over and will be the exclusive forum used for any suit brought to collect such fees.

Conflicts of Interest. To prevent any future misunderstanding and to preserve the firm's ability to represent you and our other clients, we confirm our agreement regarding certain conflicts of interest issues:
