The Board of Trustees welcomes public participation, consistent with the Brown Act, on items that appear on the agenda and those items that are not appearing on the agenda. If you wish to address the Board during the Public Comment section of the meeting or during the corresponding item section, you must complete and submit an electronic Public Comment Card or submit a paper Public Comment Card to the Executive Assistant or designee prior to the General Open Session of the meeting. Individuals are not required to sign in, or otherwise disclose their name or other information as a condition of attending a meeting or addressing the Board. You will be called upon to speak during the Public Comment section or the specified agendized item you have selected. If you prefer not to provide your name, you will need to provide how you wish to be identified when called upon. If you are attending the School Board meeting via Zoom please make sure that the name on the Public Comment Card matches the name you enter when joining the Zoom Meeting. However, understand the Board may not take action on any item which is not listed on this agenda (except as authorized by Government Code Section 54954.2). (BB9323), The Board may ask clarifying questions related to the public comments made on items appearing on the agenda or the Board may refer such matter to the Superintendent or designee. (Education Code 35145.5, Government Code 54954.2). Individual speakers shall be allowed three minutes to address the Board on any agendized or non-agendized item. The Board shall limit the total time for public presentation and input on all items to a maximum of 20 minutes. With Board consent, the Board President may increase or decrease the time allowed for public comment, depending on the topic and the number of persons wishing to be heard and the overall length of the agenda. The Board President may take a poll of speakers for or against a particular issue and may ask that additional persons speak only if they have something new to add. (BB 9323) Anyone may appear at the Board meeting to testify in support of, or in opposition to, any item on this agenda being presented to the Board for consideration. (If you wish to have an item placed on the agenda for discussion and/or action by the Board, you must notify the Board Secretary/Superintendent in writing no later than ten working days prior to a regularly scheduled Board meeting requesting permission. After the Superintendent's Cabinet has met, you will be notified of their decision.} If you have a comment or complaint regarding a specific employee, please refrain from making a public comment and contact the employee's supervisor for resolution.
