## AN INVITATION TO WORK ON THE DELTA

The River Delta Unified School District is made up of four elementary schools (D. H. White Elementary, K-4; Isleton Elementary, K-8; Walnut Grove Elementary, K-6; and Bates Elementary, K-6) two middle schools (Clarksburg Middle, 7-9; and Riverview Middle, 5-8); and two high schools (Rio Vista High, 9-12; and Delta High, 10-12), a continuation high school (Mokelumne High 9-12); an alternative/independent study school (River Delta High/Elementary School, 4-12), a community day school (River Delta Community Day School, 7-12) and an adult school (Wind River). The District's total enrollment is 2,228 as of the October 2007 CBEDS. However, major housing growth is anticipated within the next few years in several district communities and especially in the City of Rio Vista.

The District – a tri-county district (Yolo, Solano, Sacramento) – is administered by the Sacramento County Office of Education. The students who attend the district schools come from the various river communities of Clarksburg (Yolo), Courtland, Hood, Locke, Walnut Grove, Ryde, Isleton (Sacramento), Rio Vista, Collinsville, Birds Landing (Solano) and the vast farmlands along the Sacramento River in Central California.

The River Delta Unified School District enjoys a fine reputation for educational excellence. The River Delta teachers are not content to educate tomorrow's citizens with yesterday's methods. The professional staff continually searches for more effective approaches. The District is currently involved in a number of program improvements designed to enhance the effectiveness of instruction at all levels. The District is also involved in implementing modernization construction at most sites based on two District bonds and other growth funds now available to the District.

The major industry is agriculture. Within this Delta area is some of the richest farm land in the United States. Fruits, grains and vegetables are among the major crops.

The District is located in the heart of a great recreational area. With a maze of rivers and sloughs which make up the Delta, boating, water skiing, swimming and fishing become favorite past times. For those who like the mountains and snow, Lake Tahoe and the High Sierras are within easy driving distance. The metropolitan areas of Sacramento, Stockton, Fairfield, Vacaville, Oakland and San Francisco provide plenty of opportunity for city life.

The River Delta Unified School District is located near many outstanding colleges, junior and vocational colleges and universities. Delta College in Stockton, Solano College in Suisun/Fairfield, Sacramento City College, Healds College, MTI, California State University at Sacramento, University of the Pacific, University of California at Davis and Berkeley, to name just a few, are within commuting distance.
